Team Merrill Lynch/PaySimple will ride in the MS 150 Bike Tour to create awareness about MS and to raise money for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society.

With riders, volunteers, and fundraisers, the MS 150 unites the Colorado community in enjoyment of our beautiful state and in support of the fight against MS," said Jeff Gardner, President of PaySimple and the company's lead rider.
